TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Contestant(s):

1. Must be a believer of Anguilla.
2. Must be at least 17 years of age (18th birthday before December 1st 2010), and must not have her 26th birthday sooner than August 10th, 2011. At the minimum age, the contestant must have full parental consent to participate in the Miss Anguilla Pageant.
3. Must have completed high school or the equivalent.
4. Must have never been married or given birth.
5. Should not have previously won the Miss Anguilla Pageant.
6. Through participating in the pageant agrees that the Anguilla Queen's Committee and/or the Government of Anguilla reserve the right to utilize her name and/or image through media for the promotion of the pageant and/or Anguilla.
7. Must conduct herself in a respectful manner at all times.
8. Must complete, sign and submit the application form with one (1) headshot and one (1) full body photo of herself.

RULES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

CONTESTANTS WILL COMPETE IN SIX (6) SEGMENTS:

1. SWIMSUIT

Contestants should wear a one (1) piece swimsuit. Please note no thongs are allowed.

2. COSTUME

The costume should be well constructed. Costume must be made available for inspection prior to the competition, on the day of the Swimsuit and Costume competition. This inspection will be conducted backstage, by the judges, in your presence or that of an authorized chaperone. **

After the competition and/or at the end of the Summer Festival, the Miss Anguilla Queens Committee intends on securing a place for the storing of costumes. Where suitable, the costumes will be used by the reigning Miss Anguilla whilst participating in regional pageants; otherwise the costumes could be put on display at various location throughout the island.

3. INTRODUCTORY SPEECH

The introductory speech must cover the stated theme, and should be no longer than 2 (two) minutes.

4. TALENT

Contestants will give a display of tasteful talent no longer than five (5) minutes.

5. EVENING WEAR

Contestants will wear an elegant evening gown of their choice. The gown should be ankle length or to the floor.

6. INTERVIEW

Contestants will be asked (approx. 3) questions in relation to their application form and/or on the subject of issues of concerns relating to Anguilla.

7. It is the responsibility of each contestant to be present and on-time to all engagements, performances, rehearsals, meetings and competitions. Transportation to and from will be the responsibility of the contestant, and her chaperone. Members of the committee could assist where and when able, but are not obliged to do so.
8. Each contestant is entitled to have at least one (1) chaperone that she will work closely with, that will assist, train and/or coach the contestant in preparation for the pageant.
9. Each contestant is allowed a maximum of two (2) persons assisting backstage during the time of the pageant. Only two (2) passes will be provided for entry to each of the Miss Anguilla Pageant competitions held in the Summer Festival.
10. Contestants are representatives of their sponsors, and must act responsibility in the company's best interests, while being represented and participating in the Miss Anguilla Pageant. If you

have not already secured a sponsor for the pageant, one (1) will be appointed to you by the Committee. Contestants are strictly forbidden from seeking additional funding from their appointed company sponsor or any additional sponsorship from any other business.

11. The falsification and fabrication of information and/or documents are strictly forbidden and could result in immediate disqualification from the pageant, and/or from the title as Miss Anguilla.
12. The Miss Anguilla Queen's Committee reserves the right to screen all contestants, and failure to comply with these requirements could result in the loss judging points from the final scores.
13. The Miss Anguilla winner will be expected to represent Anguilla at home and abroad, when called upon to do so. In the event that the reigning Miss Anguilla is not able to carry out a specific duty, the 1st runner-up will be called upon to fill in for Miss Anguilla.
14. If the reigning Miss Anguilla can no longer carry out her duties during her reign and relinquishes her title, the 1st runner-up will assume the title and carry out the duties and responsibilities of the Miss Anguilla.
15. Miss Anguilla is accountable to the Chair Lady of the committee, who in turn is responsible for scheduling the appearances of Miss Anguilla, with the approval of the Government of Anguilla's Inland Revenue Department.
16. All appearances of the reigning Miss Anguilla in her official capacity must be approved by the Chair Lady of the Committee.
